**RE: Notice Regarding Order Types and Order Indications that Are Eligible for Entry to and Accepted by the CHX Matching System**

---

Under CHX Article 20, Rule 4(b), **effective Thursday, January 5, 2012**, the ISO Cross order type will not be eligible for entry to or accepted by the Exchange's Matching System. Order types and order indications not eligible for entry to the Matching System will be rejected by the Exchange. This notice does not change the basic requirements an order must meet under CHX Article 20, Rule 4(a).

As of the above-referenced effective date, the following order types and indications (as defined under CHX Article 20, Rule 4(b)) shall be eligible for entry to and accepted by the Matching System:

- (1) BBO Intermarket Sweep (BBO ISO)
- (2) Benchmark
- (3) Cancel on Halt
- (4) Cross
- (5) Cross with Size
- (6) Day
- (7) Do Not Display
- (8) Do Not Route
- (9) Fill or Kill (FOK)
- (10) Immediate or Cancel (IOC)
- (11) IOC Market
- (12) Intermarket Sweep (ISO)
- (13) Non-Regular Way Cross
- (14) Post Only
- (15) Price-Penetrating ISO
- (16) Reserve Size
- (17) Sell Short
- (18) Post Only ISO
- (19) Time in Force
- (20) CHX Only
